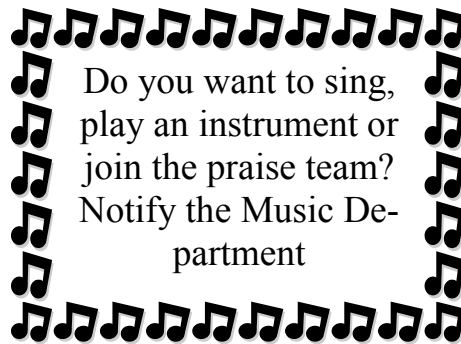
## The Countdown

Function: *verb* Inflected Form

Etymology: Middle English *besechen*, from *be-* + *sechen* to seek Date: 12th century  
*transitive verb* 1 : to beg for urgently or anxiously 2 : to request earnestly : implore  
*intransitive verb* : to make supplication

Biblical facts: The word beseech appears in the KJV 67 times.
